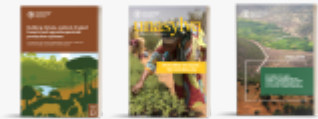

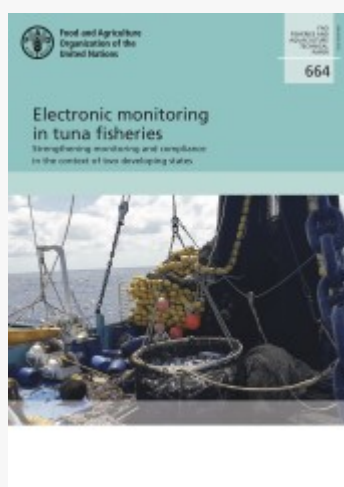

EAF-Nansen Programme

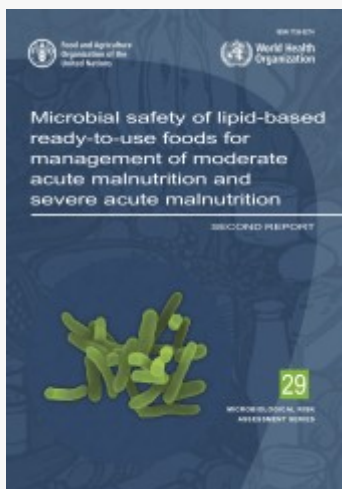

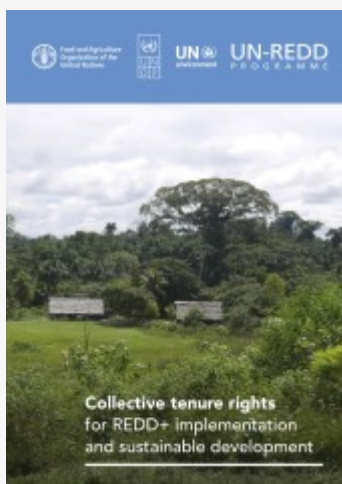
