

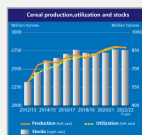
## HIGHLIGHTS



### FAO Food Price Index

The index tracks monthly changes in the international prices of commonly traded food commodities. It averaged 154.2 points in June 2022, down 3.7 points from May 2022, marking the third consecutive monthly decline.

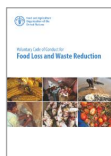


Crop Prospects and Food Situation - Quarterly Global Report No. 2, July 2022

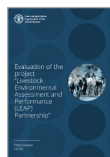
## EVALUATIONS



### Évaluation de la vulnérabilité du secteur agricole aux changements climatiques et identification d'options d'adaptation dans la zone des Niayes au Sénégal. Rapport produit dans le cadre du projet Sécurité alimentaire: une agriculture adaptée (SAGA)

This study aims to assess the current and future vulnerability of agriculture to climate change in the Niayes region. The results show a significant interannual variability of current rainfall in the Tivaouane, Kébémér and Louga regions, as well as an increase in average temperature of 1.7 °C compared to 1986.

The evaluation finds that tailoring interventions to the local context enabled cost savings in constructing water infrastructure. It also indicates that promoting local ownership through a coordinated partnership approach is a good practice to be applied in future programme implementation.
